  - Dissemination and delivery of AAEBIs through: 1) a project to engage employers as payors of Walk With Ease; 2) Walk With Ease hub grants
- **1802 – Strengthening Public Health Systems and Services Through National Partnerships**

# Arthritis Council

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The Arthritis Council's primary objectives are to:

- **Represent** state health department arthritis programs and related issues and concerns within NACDD.
- **Link** state/territorial/tribal program directors/coordinators, and others in a national forum to act collectively in the promotion of Arthritis health.
- **Exchange** ideas, strategies, materials, and policies and procedures to improve and enhance comprehensive public health programs/policies for Arthritis diseases and their risk factors.
- **Advocate** for legislation, policies and programs to reduce the burden of Arthritis diseases and their risk factors.
- **Provide** comments and recommendations to federal agencies and the membership on issues for which comment has been solicited or for which the Council feels comments are required.
- **Offer** leadership and develop partnerships with affiliates, private and public associations and industry to catalyze promotion of Arthritis health.

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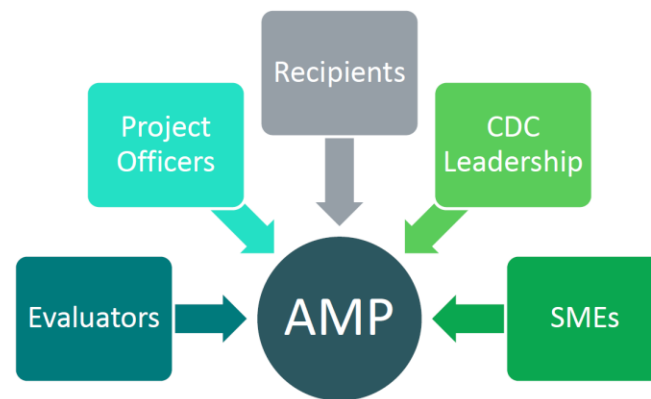

## WHAT IS THE AWARD MANAGEMENT PLATFORM (AMP)?

- AMP is a platform for internal and external stakeholders to collaborate on **post-award management**
- AMP provides a program-specific community that will **enhance the user experience** and offer new ways to engage with other users.



### Navigation Tips

- 🏠 ⭐ ⚙️ **Accessing the Award Management Platform (AMP):** AMP is a web-based platform, which means you can bookmark your favorite pages for quick access. This may include the login page, collaboration groups, the technical assistance submission page, and more.
- ⬅️ ➡️ **Navigating between pages:** AMP comes equipped with a navigation menu to quickly access Groups, Technical Assistance, Resources, Contacts, Dashboard, and Calendar. You can also use your internet browser's back and forward buttons to move between pages.
- @ **Bringing other AMP users into a conversation:** AMP is designed to reduce email traffic when possible. If you want someone to receive an email notification, you can mention their name with an @ symbol. For example, if you write a comment that says, "@Tina Turner, come check this out," Tina will receive an email linking her to this post. She can open the link in AMP to reply, or she can reply to the email she received. Either way, AMP will add her comment to the conversation. You should use @mentions when you are interacting in groups and commenting on technical assistance. Note: @mentions only apply to users with access to AMP.
- + Follow **Following technical assistance requests:** Tracking technical assistance is one of the main functions in AMP. To stay up-to-date on an existing technical assistance request, you can click the "+ Follow" button in the right-hand corner of the Technical Assistance Details page. By doing so, you will receive an email every time an update is made on the request – even when not you are not @mentioned.

### Dictionary of Key Terms

Some of the technology terms you see in AMP may feel new at first. Below are some definitions for the most common ones:

- **Article:** How resources are stored in AMP. Articles contain a title, summary, attachment, and/or URL. This page is what makes resources searchable in AMP.
- **Case:** A technical assistance inquiry in AMP. Cases contain details on the CDC staff member(s) involved in resolution, a recipient point-of-contact, and any back-and-forth exchanges.
  - **Assigned Case Owner:** The primary CDC staff member responsible for resolving a case. When you submit a case, AMP automatically routes it to the right CDC staff member.
  - **Case Contributor:** A secondary CDC staff member your PO may tag to help resolve a case. You will see their name next to the Case Owner under Case Overview.
  - **Post:** Area on the left side of the case page where your team and CDC staff can discuss back-and-forth. You can use @mentions to make sure other AMP users receive email notifications when it is helpful.
- **Digest:** Your email notification settings. In AMP, you can choose how often you receive emails from each group you belong to. You can receive emails for every post, daily summaries, weekly summaries, or limited (meaning you will only receive notifications if you are @mentioned). Because digests are summaries, you cannot directly reply to a digest email. You can only direct reply @mention notification emails.
